Preface written by famous photographer

The preface is written by well-known nature and art photographer Mats Andersson, who also designed the book. In the preface he writes "An image emanating melancholy. Fictional, or possibly some sort of self-portrait? A saddened puffin in the foreground is looking at a group of people appearing as dark, ghostlike silhouettes. Is the sad bird and the photographer one and the same - someone in the process of excluding others. The image touches me and provokes thought. To me this is what good photography is all about."
